MARK-FOAM is a specially formulated product used to kill foam on contact. It is designed to be sucked up through the vacuum hose of a hot water extractor, or sprayed into the recovery opening of a direct hook-up water rinser or extractor.

MARK-FOAM may also be diluted 1 part concentrate to 4 parts water and sprayed directly onto shampooed carpeting prior to extracting.

MARK-FOAM is a concentrated milky emulsion containing polysiloxane. It is used to prevent foam build-up or suppress existing foam during carpet shampoo operations. . .especially in hot water extraction systems.

MARK-FOAM is a neutral liquid that is safe for use on all fabrics and surfaces not harmed by water. It effectively controls foam caused by protein soils, soaps and detergents.

RECOMMENDED USES:

- Extractors
- Automatic Scrubbers
- Wet Vacuum

BENEFITS:

- Affective against a broad range of foam sources.
- Does not form residue

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

DO NOT mix Mark-Foam with extraction cleaner prior to cleaning.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Shake well before using.

Whenever excess foaming is encountered during extraction, mix 2 oz. of **MARK-FOAM** to 12 oz. of water in a separate container and suck up through the vacuum hose while the machine is running. The container should be used only for this purpose. This will enable the hose to become coated with the defoamer and begin to eliminate the foam before it gets to the recovery tank.

With direct hook-up machines, mix solution in the same proportion as above, but place in a trigger sprayer and spray directly into recovery opening of rinsing head. You also may need to coat the inside of the vacuum hose in the same manner as described above, if machine has a vacuum hose.

MARK-FOAM is a very effective product, but the usage may need to be increased if there is excessive suds build-up in the carpeting.
