Volatile Dry Spotter *Desmanchador Seco Volatil*

This volatile dry spotter has been formulated for removal of petroleum related soils without water from carpets, rugs and upholstery. It removes grease, tar, oil, asphalt, rubber, chewing gum, enamel paint, varnish, stain, lacquer, glue and many others. Since this spotter contains no water and cannot be mixed with water, it may be used on fabrics that would ordinarily "bleed" dye or severely shrink in cleaning.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GENERAL SPOTTING PROCEDURE

Before using, test a small inconspicuous area with the spotter and note any color change.

To apply, saturate a piece of white absorbent toweling or cheese cloth with spotter and blot stained area lightly. Then tamp with a spotting brush. Allow the solvent to soak into old dried stains. Clean by rubbing toward the center of the stain from all sides. Avoid overwetting the stained area as this may damage rubber or foam backed carpet. Repeat as necessary to completely remove spot and allow to air dry. This solvent may also be used as a dry extraction cleaner through special equipment.
