**DIRECTIONS:**

**BONNET CLEANING**

- 1) Vacuum carpet thoroughly to remove as much soil as possible.
- 2) Dilute SafeGuard Bonnet Shampoo as follows:
  - a) Light Soil @ 8 ounces per gallon
  - b) Medium Soil @ 10 ounces per gallon
  - c) Heavy Soil @ 12 ounces per gallon
- 3) SafeGuard Bonnet Shampoo may be used as follows:
  - a) Immerse carpet bonnet in a bucket containing SafeGuard Bonnet Shampoo.
 Remove from solution and wring dry.

**OR**

- b) Place bonnet on the bottom of the floor machine. Spray bonnet with properly diluted Bonnet Dry Foam Shampoo using a pump sprayer. Lightly mist carpet area to be cleaned

with SafeGuard Bonnet Shampoo also.

- 4) Bonnet clean a 100 to 150 square foot area and repeat steps 3a or 3b.
- 5) Turn or replace bonnet pad when it becomes exceptionally soiled.
- 6) Allow carpet to dry. Vacuum thoroughly.

**DRY FOAM OR MIST CLEANING**

- 1) Vacuum carpet thoroughly.
- 2) Dilute at 12 ounces per gallon.
- 3) Follow normal mist or dry foam shampoo procedures.

*\*As with all cleaning products, always check for colorfastness on carpeting and upholstery in an inconspicuous area before using these products.*

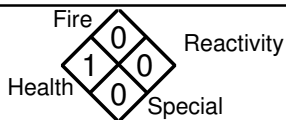
